


A Preposition


relates a noun or pronoun to another word.





Stand up on point "beyond"

beyond



Finger over lips

head tilt, hands over heart

Squat, hands down on knees

down



* stay in squat, wave motion with one hand

during



*stay in squat, arms cross at "x" in front of body

except



standing, palms up and out like giving, "this is "for" you."

for



bring hands in like taking something from someone

from



ASL "in" place right hand fingers in to left hand cup

in



while in "in" motion, crouch down like getting inside box

inside



Stand up, hold up "2"

into



finger on cheek, tilt head (valley girl)

like



like leaning into a person to be near them.

near



Sign language "o" ; "f"

of



one hand on top of other and take off

off



bring hand back down on top of other

on



like getting onto a horse, hold reins and small jump to side

onto



point out with thumb

out



rise ; turn to look outside

outside



move one hand over the other

over



hand slaps other hand as it moves past.

past



shake finger

regarding



look at watch

since



hands together part like going through something

through



circle around from through, motion "through" again bringing hands all the way out to sides

throughout



Point to where you want to go

to



Holding "to" motion, take two steps forward

toward



Hand over head so you're under

under



hand over hand & squat

underneath



* stay in squat one finger comes down to touch the other

until



Standing up and up motion with palms

up



from palms up, circle around to palms down.

upon



ASL "with" fists together touching

with



palms up, turn over to palms down while moving hands forward

within



from "with" fists together motion, back step, pulling hands apart into "jazz hands."
